Important Details for the 2018 Hinkley Clean Up Day:

- Due to state law only 9 waste tires can be transported to the clean up site per resident. Residents can make several trips with 9 tires but only 9 will be accepted for each trip. Tires must be removed from rims and the maximum tire size accepted will be 11" by 25.5" (which includes most passenger car/SUV tires and some semi truck tires).
- This program is limited to residents of unincorporated Hinkley.
- Oversized or hard to handle loads must be bagged in order to expedite off loading into the trash bin. Loose loads such as roofing material, tile, small green waste or cement take more time to off load which clogs up the bin for use by others. Residents with hard to handle loads may be diverted to the landfill for disposal at their own cost.
- We cannot accept commercial or industrial waste from businesses.
- We cannot accept any hazardous waste such as used oil, antifreeze, drain cleaners, paint, paint buckets, paint thinners, wood preservatives, fluorescent lighting, pesticides, fertilizers or gasoline.
- We cannot accept dead animals.
